HOMEWORK POLICY

"The School's policies which are made from time to time are made pursuant to the requirements set out in section 47 of the Education Act and of the Board of Studies for registration for the school."

Sherwood Hills Christian School incorporates the use of Homework at all grade levels. The level of homework for each grade differs according to the requirements of each Key Learning Area.

Student Responsibility

It is the student's responsibility to ensure that the required homework is recorded in their homework diary. This will be checked on a daily basis. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure that all homework is completed in a satisfactory manner.

Parent Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the parent to ensure that all homework is completed each night. Parents are asked to sign the homework diary, according to each department's specifications, once your child has completed their homework.

School Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the school to ensure that each child has the means by which they can complete their homework in the allotted amount of time. The school must check each student's homework diary each day; to ensure that the student's parent has signed the diary according to the relevant department's requirements, and that the student has recorded the correct amount of homework.

Failure to complete assigned homework will result in discipline measures being instigated according to classroom procedures.

The Headmaster is responsible for the updating of this policy document.

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
